What Do the Children Need to Bring to Summer Camp?

- Backpack containing all personal belongings LABELLED with your family name or child's name on them (extra clothes, please)
- Bag lunch (or purchase hot lunch Wednesday's and Friday's-\$4)
- 2 extra snacks daily
- Refillable water bottle, filled with water. This may be filled throughout the day at the water filling stations at school.
- Wear running shoes or closed toed shoes for gym and outdoor activities
- Change of clothes in a large Ziploc bag in their backpack (labelled)
- Hat, Bug Spray and Sunscreen* (*for each family member in separate groups, please)
- Water Days-Bathing Suit, Water shoes and Towel

School Age Group Daily Routine***

10:30am-11:45am	Camp programming/Outdoor free choice activities/time to run and play
11:45am-12:30pm	Washroom/wash hands/Lunch
12:30pm-12:45pm	Relaxing activities (card games, reading etc.)
12:45pm-2pm	Planned special activities/Camp programming/Choice time/Arts and crafts/sports etc. the group may separate into groups based on interests

11:30am-12:30pm	Washroom/wash hands/Lunch
1pm-1:30pm	Gym Time (group games and free time to explore the equipment)
1:30pm-3pm	Small Group Learning/Open Play Centre/Choice Time/Planned Activities
3pm-3:30pm	Snack Time/Small Circle Sunscreen application
3:30pm-4:30pm	Outdoor Play and Activities
4:30pm-6pm	Multi Stations/Prepare for Home

***Please Note: in both groups, these are approximate times, activities and routines will be based on the children's interest in the activities

How Should I Pay For Lunches and Activities?

All activities and food days must be paid via cash before the day that the activity/food is occurring, as we will be paying the vendor directly. Please submit these extra funds to the Supervisor. For Subway Days, there will be a form to fill out prior to the day of the lunch, this form must be in to the Supervisor the Friday before.

What to Expect at Drop Off and Pick Times?

- Drop Off and Pick Up will be at the West End of the school, there will be NO access to the front of the school (signs will be posted)
- We will follow current guidance from Windsor/Essex County Health Unit WECHU for Screening Procedures

- Parents/Guardians will not have access to enter the school, we will bring your child/ren to their classroom as well at pick up time we will bring them out to you
 - Parents/Guardians must wear a mask at drop off and pick up times
 - One family at a time in the screening area
